Started in 1989, CGC is a certification program that is designed to reward dogs who have good manners at home and in the community. The Canine Good Citizen Program is a two-part program that stresses responsible pet ownership for owners and basic good manners for dogs. ### **DID YOU KNOW...**

Did you know that the Glendale Police K-9 Unit is funded in part by donations and not a cent from tax payers is used? The K-9 Unit is the only part of the police department that is not included in the City's budget. ALL the proceeds from this event go DIRECTLY to the K-9 program! The yearly maintenance cost for all four K-9s, including food, training, and equipment, is approximately \$15,000. All four dogs will need to be replaced in the next 3-4 years once they reach retirement age. The replacement costs, including the purchase, training, and cross-training (narcotics or explosives) is approximately \$25,000 for EACH dog. Glendale K-9s in the Park is our only major fundraiser each year. Come out and have a GREAT time and help a GREAT cause!
